Wyoming State Land and Investment Board received federal American Rescue Plan grant funds that have been made available through specific grant programs. The City is applying for a Water and Sewer grant to provide critically needed flood control at East Del Range Boulevard and Van Buren Avenue. The grant is scored on a point system, so we are working to maximize our competitiveness to receive these funds. The project is estimated to cost up to \$2M and the City Engineer anticipates using up to 50% match funds from the 5th Penny Tax fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING, that a grant application requesting up to \$900,000.00 be submitted to the State Loan and Investment Board, for consideration to State Loan and Investment Board meeting to assist in funding the Van Buren Avenue Flood Control project.
